


What does O'Clock Mean?

What does o'clock mean in terms of PinWoofers Amplifier Controls?

- The “o'clock” reference to a control knob setting refers to the knob position viewed “straight-on”, as if it were the hour hand of an analog clock.
- For example, looking at the control knob illustration shown to the right, this knob is positioned at “10 o'clock”.
- Below are other examples.
- It does not matter which amplifier you have; the “o'clock” reference is always the same, viewing the knob “straight-on” as if pointed to one of 12 possible hours on a clock.
