PinWoofer Stand Alone Power Board Instructions

Locate CN7

- If there is an existing PinWoofer power board at this header location, set it aside since your new Stand-Alone Power Board will replace it.
- In the backbox, locate CN7 on the CPU Node Board as shown in the yellow box.





Unplug CN7

• Unplug the CN7 connector as shown in the yellow box.





Remove Tape Backing

- Locate the Stand-Alone Power Board Unit.
- Remove the tape backing as shown in the yellow box.
- Do not touch the tape adhesive or it can lose its adhesion properties.







Locate Stud

• Locate the #8-32 factory stud above the CPU Node Board as shown in the yellow box.



Mount Board

- In a single motion, paying attention to parallel alignment of module to the top of the backbox enclosure, place the tab over the stud and press the taped tab to the back-place and shown in the yellow circles.
- Secure the tab with the supplied #8 flat washer and #8-32 Nylon Locking Nut. Gently hand tighten until secure. Do not over tighten.





Plug Machine Harness

- Plug the previously liberated machine harness into the right-hand header on the Stand-Alone Power Board as shown in the yellow circle.
- The connector and header are keyed so match them up correctly.
- The fit should be "natural" with no need for excessive force.
- If you are uncertain of what you are doing at any point, stop immediately and contact PinWoofer.





Plug New Harness

- Plug the new Stand-Alone Power Board Wire harness into the left-hand header on the Stand-Alone Power Board as shown in the yellow circle.
- The connector and header are keyed so match them up correctly.
- The fit should be "natural" with no need for excessive force.
- If you are uncertain of what you are doing at any point, stop immediately and contact PinWoofer.

• Study the image carefully and ensure that your work is identical.





Plug to CN7

- Plug the new Stand-Alone Power Board Wire harness into CN7 as shown in the yellow circle.
- The connector and header are keyed so match them up correctly.
- The fit should be "natural" with no need for excessive force.
- If you are uncertain of what you are doing at any point, stop immediately and contact PinWoofer.





Plug PinWoofer Power Connector

 Plug the PinWoofer Harness Power connector as shown in the yellow circle.





View of Completed Work

- Study the image to the right carefully.
- Make certain that your work matches the image.
- Secure the newly installed harness to a nearby wire loom using a cable tie or other method to prevent a shadow from being cast on the machine backglass / translight.
