

PinWoofer Power Board


- Unplug the 5-Pin Factory Connector from CN7.
- Plug the Power Board into CN7.
- •Plug the 5-Pin Factory Connector into the Power Board.
- Plug the PinWoofer Harness 2-Pin Power Connector into the Power Board.



PinWoofer Expander Board

- Unplug the 5-Pin Factory Connector from CN1.
- Unplug the 2-Pin Factory Connector from CN4.
- Simultaneously plug the Expander Board into CN1 and CN4.
- Plug the PinWoofer Harness
 3.5mm TRS Plug into the Expander
 Board.
- The connectors that originally went to CN1 and CN4 are no longer needed.











When auto-mute is enabled the LED auto-mute indicator will glow red. Note that auto-mute may remain enabled during machine menu navigation, and navigation sounds will be quieter than before.






APYLISTMENTS

After installation, turn the machine on and follow the below startup procedure:

1. In the machine's menu enter the below settings:

SERVICE MENU > UTIL > VOL: Volume 15, All others "(DEFAULT)" SERVICE MENU > ADJ > FEAT ADJ > SPEECH ATTENUATION -5 SERVICE MENU > ADJ > FEAT ADJ > MUSIC ATTENUATION 0

- **2.** Exit machine's menu.
- **3.** Turn all amplifier dials to point vertically as shown.
- **4.** Adjust amplifier controls either by starting a game, or by alternating up and down the coin door volume controls (to keep the sounds consistently playing).
- **5.** It's likely that the default amplifier control positions will not be optimized, and may sound poor. Be confident in rotating the different controls to whatever position sounds good to your ear. **Adjust at a safe volume level.**
- **6.** Your final adjustments may leave the dials in radicially different positions. This is perfectly fine, as long as you've acheived your desired results.
- **7. CRITICAL:** If the master volume of the machine and/or the gain control on the amp are too low, the auto-mute will clamp the output and reduce the volume. (The auto-mute function may even alternate on/off.) Watching the auto-mute LED will inform you of this condition. Correct by simply increasing the machine's volume and/or the amplifier's gain control.
- **8.** It is recommended that the Gain is adjusted to 50-75% clockwise, and the volume of the title is adjusted to the low end, about 10-20. These adjustments will provide a strong input signal and margin for the auto-mute function.
- **9. Never set title volume above 30;** lower settings give better quality. **10.** Significant changes in backbox or cabinet menu settings can result in a highly driven signal, so listen carefully after making any adjustments. It is highly recomended that you use the settings in Step 1
